#### HOW TO GET THERE

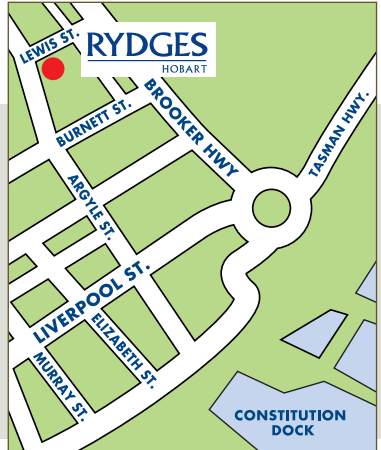

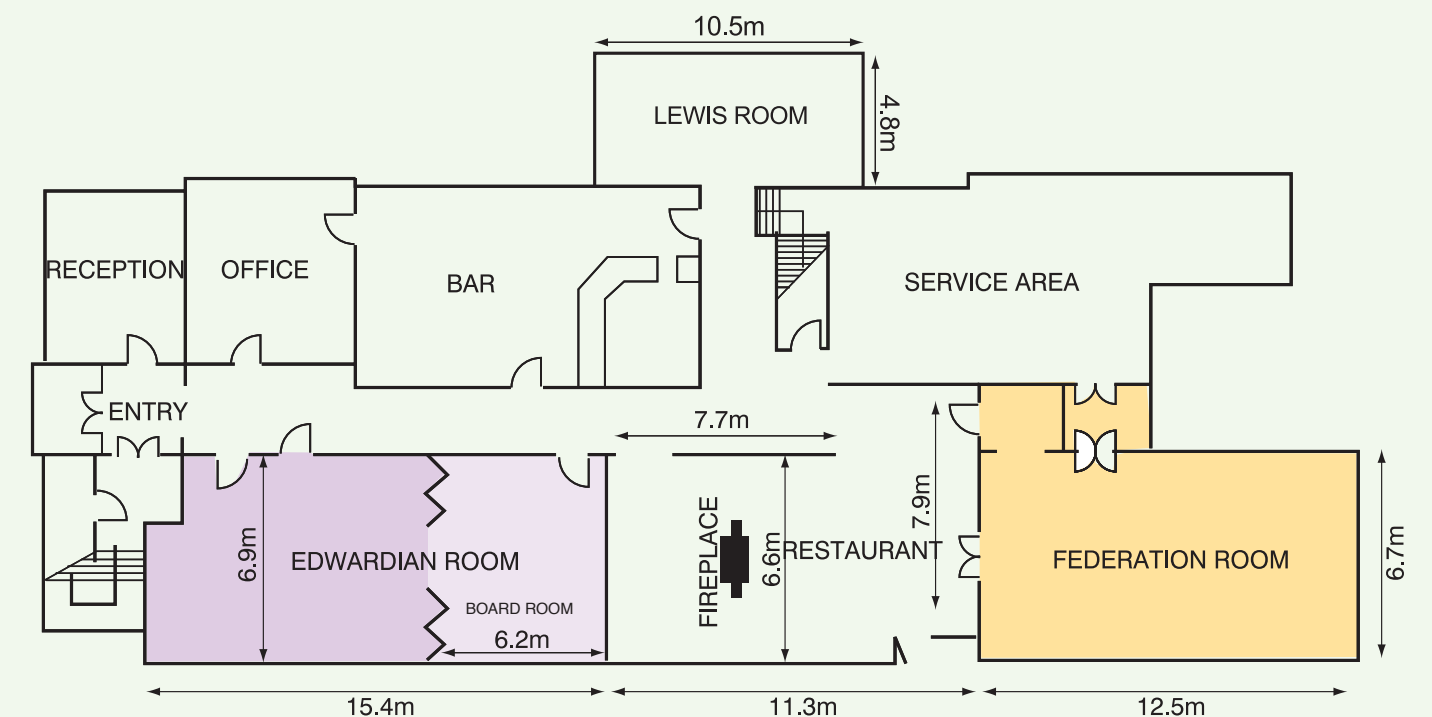
### DINING CONCEPTS
